Wed Nite Live is Bringing the Word!

What is Wed Nite Live? WNL is an intentional setting where God's children of all ages, from 2 years of age to adults, can learn about Christian relationships by gathering together.

What are the dates and times? Fall Semester: Wed. Sept. 14 through Wed. Nov. 30. 5-7 PM for children and youth. Adult studies 5:30-6:30 PM. Dinner service will begin at 6:20.

What is the cost for fall semester? 2, 3, 4 year olds: \$40/child

K-High School: \$50/child with a family maximum of \$125.

Adults: \$7 for dinner/session

Free nursery available for children under 2.

What will be studied?

2 year old through 6th grade: *Unwrapping the Greatest Gift*.

7-8th graders will be preparing for Confirmation.

High school students will explore Being Presbyterian in the Bible Belt.

Young and Older Adults will have three tracts from which to choose:

Living the Questions, an opportunity to struggle with some tough theological issues and explore what's next for Christianity, led by Bert Moore and Barbara Bozeman.


Old Testament Survey: an invitation to explore the general themes of the Old Testament, led by Rev. Richard Brooks, retired PC(USA).


