Our church's missional focus this month is on these international missions. Each week of July you will find information about one of the many programs we currently support. Please pray for these organizations and all who work for them, as well as the people they serve. These are some of the places around the world where our church is currently making an impact.

Rwanda, Africa Mission Projects

In Rwanda The Outreach Foundation (TOF) supports a variety of projects that enable recovery, reconciliation and growth following the indescribably horrible 1994 genocide. The Outreach Foundation promotes new church construction, scholarships for seminary students, peacemaking training, vocational training, and support to vulnerable children in the inner city of Kigali. Our church in particular has sponsored scholarships and medical fees for elementary through college-aged students, participated in peacemaking discussions and support, and donated bibles, school supplies and medical supplies. We have helped build and dedicate two new churches that also serve as community centers, in Rukamiro and Shyorongi.
