One of the biggest challenges that the Personnel Committee has faced over the past few years is what kind of staffing configuration would best serve the work of the church. In addition, we have some new budget realities that constrain what we are able to do. The Personnel Committee has faithfully been trying to address this for some time.

As a result, at the recommendation of the Personnel Committee, the session voted to dissolve the position of Executive Assistant to the Senior Pastor. In light of that, Cynde Tannehill will no longer be employed with us. I am sure for many this is sad and upsetting news as Cynde has been a friendly face to many of you. We are grateful for her years of service here and we have tried to be as generous as we can to her as she seeks new employment.

Our form of government asks elders to make the hard decisions of leading the church. They often have information that is confidential and not available to the average church member. Please continue to trust that our elders have made and will continue to make the best decisions possible for our church family. Further, if you have questions or concerns about this specific action, please speak directly with a member of the Personnel Committee or myself, as Head of Staff.

Haiti Mission Trip Update

"The Haiti Mission Team recently returned from the northwest region of Haiti, serving with mission partners Matt and Sarah Rideout at the International Missionary Fellowship hospital in Bombardopolis. The team saw more than 420 patients over two and a half days of clinic. They fitted and gave out 255 pairs of reading glasses, 54 pairs of distance glasses, and hundreds of pairs of sunglasses. The team ran out of glasses prior to running out of patients and a follow-up mission trip will be planned in the near future. Thank you for the continued prayer and support for the team and for our mission partners and friends in Haiti."
